Dating Galatians

Dating Galatians will depend upon how one dates the death and resurrection of Jesus and the calling of Saul to ministry. Galatians is usually dated to about 50-55 AD, although dates from the late 40s to the late 50s AD have all been proposed by scholars.

Date I posit: 53 -- 55 AD, with 53 AD being more likely.

A Basic Chronology of Paul's Life:

~5 AD -- 31 AD

- *Paul is born (his father is a Roman citizen)
- *Grows up in Tarsus
- *Is educated by Gamaliel in Jerusalem
- *Becomes a zealous member of the Pharisees
- 33 AD Actively persecutes members of a new Jewish sect centered in Jerusalem that claims Jesus as messiah (Gal 1:13; 1 Cor 15:9)
- 35 AD Is converted on the Road to Damascus and called to be the Apostle to the Gentiles.
- 38 AD Missionary activity in Arabia and Damascus
- 38 AD Two week visit to Jerusalem, meets Peter and James but not the larger church (Gal 1:22)
- 38 AD and following Missionary activity in Cilicia, Syria, and Greece from the Antioch church
- 50 AD Writes I Thessalonians
- 51 AD Gallio episode at Corinth
- 51 AD Peter's visit to Antioch
- 51 AD Jerusalem Council
- 51-57 AD Missionary activity in Asia Minor and Greece
 - *Writes Galatians, Philippians, Philemon, 1 & 2 Corinthians, Colossians, 2 Thessalonians
- 57 AD Writes Romans from Corinth
- 58 AD Arrives in Jerusalem with collection, is arrested and imprisoned 2 years at Caesarea
- 59-60 AD Sea journey to Rome
- 60-61/62 AD Imprisonment at Rome
 - * Dictation of the Pastoral Epistles sortly before death.
 - --> Date of Paul's death unknown, though may be 5 or 6 years after 62 AD
