Imputed Righteousness - To be considered as righteous as Jesus. To be declared not guilty of sin due to the sacrifice of Jesus. To have God's righteousness ascribed to you.

Imparted Righteousness - To actually have the righteousness of God become part of you.

To **Propitiate** [trans.] to win or regain the favor of (a god, spirit, or person) by doing something that pleases them. To pay for something.

Propitiation [noun] the action of propitiating or appeasing a god, spirit, or person.

Expiation or Expiate [trans] to atone, or pay, for guilt or sin.

iλαστήριον – ("hilasterion") the means by which sins are forgiven — 'the means of forgiveness, expiation.' & the location or place where sins are forgiven (in traditional translations rendered 'mercy seat') — 'place of forgiveness, place where sins are forgiven.' see Hebrews 9:5
