As found at 2 Corinthians 10:1--13:13

1. Address, Salutation, and Thanksgiving [Lost]

(It is believed that the original introduction to this letter was either lost before the scribe, who originally copied the letters from Corinth, did the scribal work, or there may not have been a formal opening to the letter. This second theory is likely only if we consider this a quickly hand-written letter, and therefore not characteristics of the rest of Paul's letters, which were dictated.)
